

**LAC STE. ANNE COUNTY  
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
BYLAW #25-2021**

**BEING A BYLAW FOR LAC STE. ANNE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, BEING CHAPTER M-26 OF THE STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR ADVERTISING STATUTORY NOTICES.**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to section 606 and/or 692 of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council must give notice of certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearing or other things by advertising in a newspaper or other publication circulating in the area, mailing or delivering a notice to every residence in the affected area or by another method provided for in a bylaw under section 606.1;

**WHEREAS** pursuant to section 606.1(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may, by bylaw, provide for one or more methods, which may include electronic means, for advertising proposed bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings, and other things referred to in section 606 and/or 692;

**AND WHEREAS**, Council is satisfied that the advertising method set out in this Bylaw is likely to bring matters advertised by that method to the attention of substantially all residents in the area to which the bylaw, resolution, or other thing relates or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enact as follows:

**1.Short Title**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **Advertising Bylaw or Public Notification Bylaw**

**2. Advertising Method**

2. Any notice required to be advertised under section 606 and/or 692 of the *Municipal Government Act* of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing, or other things may be given, in accordance with the timelines prescribed in section 606 and/or 692,
  - a) Publishing at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in at least one newspaper or other publication circulating in the area to which the proposed bylaw, resolution or other thing relates, or in which the meeting or hearing is being held, and/or;
  - b) Posting electronically by posting the notice prominently for two consecutive weeks on the Lac Ste. Anne County official website ([www.lzac.ca](http://www.lzac.ca)) and mobile app, and/or;
  - c) Posting electronically by posting the notice prominently for two consecutive weeks on any of the Lac Ste. Anne County official social media sites, and/or;
  - d) Posting the notice prominently for two weeks on the bulletin board provided for that purpose in the Lac Ste. Anne County Administration Office located at 56521 Range Road 65.
3. All notices relating to meetings by Council shall be established within the Lac Ste. Anne County Procedure Bylaw (as amended from time to time), and by the *Municipal Government Act*.


**3. Severability**

**4. Coming into Force**


The Bylaw shall come into force upon receipt of its third and final reading;

Read a first time this 2nd day of June, 2021.


