

LAC STE. ANNE COUNTY CONDUCTS DIVISION 6 BALLOT RECOUNT

Returning Officer updates unofficial Division 6 results to reflect October 20 recount.

Sangudo, Alberta, Thursday, October 21, 2021 – The County has today updated its unofficial 2021 municipal general election results following a recount of ballots cast for Division 6 candidates. The recount was performed on Wednesday, October 20, 2021 at 1:00 pm.

As a result of this recount, nine ballots were rejected due to their failure to meet all requirements of the *Local Authorities Election Act*. The recount has changed the unofficial outcome of Division 6 as follows:

Candidate Harvey W. Hagman conceded to Ross Bohnet following the recount, issuing the following statement:
