Anne County; and such address must be posted (with the exception of oil & gas industry development, which is regulated by the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board).

The location of your driveway along the township or range road determines the address assigned to your house or business. Please visit LSAC.ca/rural-addressing for a more thorough explanation of the rural addressing system.

To assign your address, the County requires the distance from your driveway approach to the nearest crossroad to assign your address. Consider using your vehicle odometer to make the measurement.
