Purpose: To allow for the use of Lac Ste. Anne County Fire Services apparatus to supply water to community groups for the purpose of community betterment.

Policy Statement: Lac Ste. Anne County and the Fire Services Department believe that involvement in community betterment activities promotes healthy communities.

Scope: This policy applies to all Lac Ste. Anne County Fire Stations.

Guidelines: County Council authorizes Fire Stations to provide water to community organizations, at the discretion of the County Fire Chief, for the following purposes:

- Provide recreational activities (flooding for skating rinks, etc.),
- Water supply to on-site storage tanks (for cemetery use, watering of plants, etc.),
- Community special events (for dunk tank, etc.).

As such, access to urban municipal water infrastructure for the above purposes must be approved by the applicable municipality prior to

drawing water. Applicable water charges may be reflected back to the community group on a cost-recovery basis only.
