Purpose: The Reeve recognizes the importance of co-operation and endeavors

to carry out his/her duties in such a manner as to promote co-

operation and loyalty among Councillors and staff.

Guidelines:

1. First among equals:

Not an <u>elected</u> position like a Reeve.

- All Reeve's authority is delegated by Council.

2. Chairperson:

- Primary responsibility to keep meetings orderly and efficient.
- Should promote open debate that gives all perspectives adequate floor time.
- Reeve has the same right as all Councillors to express his/her own views.
- Reeve should not use his/her chair to advance his/her own point of view.
- Reeve should bring debate to a close when it turns to argument.
- Debate should culminate in a clear motion.

3. Spokesperson for Council:

- Reeve to carry out special responsibilities delegated by Council.
- Reeve must defend Council decisions, even when in personal disagreement.
- Reeve should never act without Council decision, except in extreme emergencies. In this case Council ratification must be sought as soon as possible.
- 4. Reeve Must Respect and Work within all Council and Administrative Structures:
 - No authority to supersede committees.
 - No authority to criticize or interfere with Administration without direct Council instruction.
